

IGIC Executive Committee Teleconference March 6, 2007

A teleconference meeting was held on March 6, 2007, to discuss the possibility of funds available from the US Geological Survey for acquiring aerial photography in Iowa. In a late budgeting process, Bob Lemen, USGS Liaison to Iowa, was able to secure \$200K for the State of Iowa to start acquiring orthophotography.

The following motion was put forth to the IGIC Executive Committee:

- 1. To agree with the USGS to accept the money and spend it as "the initial" phase of acquiring state-wide orthophotography in conjunction with the planned LiDAR acquisition project.
- 2. To authorize the IGIC Remote Sensing Committee to prepare a contract identifying the specifications for obtaining photography that was envisioned in the current LiDAR project. Chris Ensminger, as Chair of the Remote Sensing Committee, will lead this effort.
- 3. To authorize Herb Kuehne, acting on behalf of the Iowa Geographic Information Council, to use these funds, if obtained from the USGS, to acquire as much photography as the money allotted would allow.

This motion was moved by Brad Cutler and seconded by Anne Packard. All IGIC Executive Committee members present voted aye.
