#### **Welcome - Call Meeting to Order**

Ben Wagner called the meeting to order at 10:02 am. General introductions and roll call.

#### **Approve Agenda**

Josh Obrecht requested that we add a discussion about elections to the agenda. Josh Obrecht made a motion to approve the meeting agenda and it was 2nd by Matt Hoehn. All members present voted aye.

#### **Treasurer's Report**

Josh Obrecht gave a Treasurer's Report. Current balance as of 4/30/2022 is \$32,835.44 . *See attached Treasurer's Report.*

#### **By-Law Change and Vote**

Josh Obrecht grammatically cleaned up the existing IGIC By-Laws and asked those changes to be approved. Josh made a motion to approve those changes and it was 2nd by Anya Butt. All Board members presented voted aye.

The next By-Law change was in reference to how vacancies are handled. The second change will be in Article IV, Section 9 in regards to Board vacancies. This is to place into the bylaws what was approved last meeting for the current elections.

#### **Old**

Should a vacancy occur on a sitting Board, the Chair shall request that the Membership and Nominations Committee identify individuals who are not Board members, who work in the appropriate interest sector, and

who are willing to fill the vacancy until the next regular Board election. At its next quarterly meeting the Board of Directors shall appoint one of those individuals to serve out the vacant position.

### **New**

If a member leaves the Board and is a sector representative, the sector seat will be filled from available at-large members (who represent that sector). Any remaining unfilled Board positions will be filled by the IGIC Board at its next quarterly meeting. This individual will fill the vacancy until the next regular Board election.

Brandon Lane made a motion to approve the above motion and it was 2nd by Josh Obrecht. All IGIC Board members present voted aye.

### **Elections**

Josh Obrecht and Micah Cutler need to finalize the election nomination form and will send it to the IGIC email list. It will be a Google form. The nomination period will end on May 15th. Penny Vossler and Ben Wagner's positions are set as they are the current Chair and Vice-Chair.

### **Education Committee Report**

Debbie Stevens reported that she and Amy Logan presented at the Iowa Events Center for the Iowa Technology Teachers Connection (ITEC) Conference. Our presentation was "Spreading the Mapping Bug." We were the last presentation on the second (and last) day of the conference. Only four teachers came.

On July 20 and 21, 2022, William Penn will host a teacher workshop in Oskaloosa. It is a done deal; they are working on CEUs and Masters credit, as well as getting the marketing materials done so they can send information to school districts before the school year is over. There will be inexpensive housing available and they may ask for an IGIC mini grant for a small GIS themed gift bag to give to participants. If this training is successful, they'd like to have one in central Iowa.

Schools need to turn in mapping submissions to the K-12 competition on May 11th. Debbie will be asking IGIC members to be judges. If you would like to be a judge, please contact Debbie.

Robin McNeely reported that ITAG is coming up on June 14-17, 2022, with two workshops -1) Migrating to ArcGIS Pro and 2) Field Maps. Seiler and Iowa State University are holding a hands-on GPS workshop on the ISU campus on May 12th, starting at 10 am.

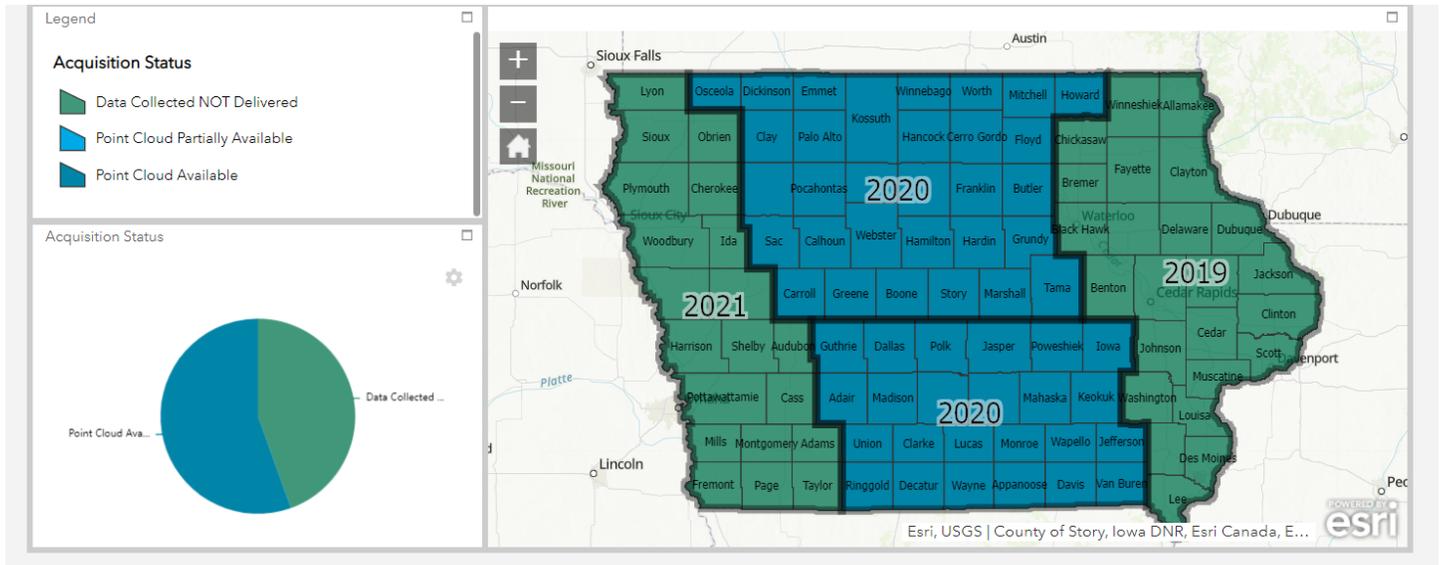
### **State of Iowa Activities**

Patrick Wilke-Brown reported that he and Casey Kohrt have been working on changes to the Iowa GIS data hub. They will be attending the MAGIC clearinghouse summit in August. Casey and Patrick will be presenting at the ITAG in West Des Moines in June 2022 on ArcGIS Online best practices and standards for data publishing, both for public consumption and within your organization.

The OCIO is changing the broadband grant program to be more location based than block based. It will use the Uber hexagon system, which is used to identify addresses and index addresses to answer that "what is where" question. Basically for every address, there is a unique key, even for sub-addresses (apartments, units, etc). It can use a "key" across address systems instead of having to clean up each address source.

Gregg Hadish reported the status of the delivered 2020 LiDAR, which is the north central to south central portion of Iowa. It's available through Iowa Geographic Map Server at ISU. Western Iowa will be the next portion of the state to be

delivered. Status available at <https://geodata.iowa.gov/pages/lidar>. There was a discussion about the availability of the data for hydrology and modeling. Any questions about LiDAR and Iowa data can be directed to Patrick Wilke-Brown.



### Website Committee

Josh Obrecht reported that the Website Committee has two meetings set up with vendors to discuss a redesign/updating of the IGIC website. The committee will compile options and bring a proposal to the full IGIC Board, probably in July.

### K-12 Esri License

Debbie Stevens reported that there have been discussions about administering an Esri organization account for K-12 educators. There was a discussion about how IGIC can help educators set up their own. Matt Hoehn suggested they work with Charlie at Esri. Anna Butt also indicated she'd be willing to be a resource.
